## PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

D. Terns-Thorpe states William Delehant did a beautiful job on the Lanesville Cemetery signs on Beecher Road. She adds this was a boy scout project.

An unknown speaker asks for those who missed the application deadline for a Short-Term Rental and are now trying to make things right, will there be a penalty imposed? Also, what sites does Granicus check.

Supervisor Mahoney states the applicant will have to pay for the previous year and the upcoming year. He adds that Granicus checks approximately twenty mass-market short-term rental websites. The Town can notify Granicus of under the radar parcels to have them comply.

S. Tuomey reminds everyone that the state still has a burn ban in place until 11/30/24. Supervisor Mahoney states he did not renew the town's past 11/15 and the state ban supersedes the towns.

## **ARPA FUNDS** -Discussion

Supervisor Mahoney states that all the American Rescue Plan funds need to be obligated by 12/31/24.

\$25,000 from Greene County is obligated to assist with the Kaaterskill Rail Trail.

\$100,000 from Greene County is obligated to pay for professional services needed for the highway garage and town hall surveying and planning the complex.

\$132,000 of town funds he would like to obligate to obtain specs for a new ambulance to replace the Mercedes. Funds to be used as a down payment and the remainder of the funds to be obligated to the same pot for the town hall complex.

Supervisor Mahoney asks A. Woolheater to begin obtaining specifications for a new ambulance.

Supervisor Mahoney makes a MOTION to obligate the remainder of the Town ARPA funds for a down payment on a new ambulance and capital costs surrounding the town campus. Seconded by Councilman Semenza.
